

MEAL PROGRAMS IN BELLEVILLE, ON

(This document has been prepared for information purposes by Bridge St. United Church, Belleville – revised June 2016)

Bridge St. United Church

60 Bridge St. E., Belleville (Northwest corner of Bridge & Church Streets)

Thank God It's Friday - (TGIF) - provides takeaway, church-cooked and frozen meals, every Friday afternoon from 2 to 4 p.m. On your first visit, register by showing I.D. for the number of meals you are picking up.

End-of-the-Month – (EOTM) – Held on two days in the last week of each month – all year long. Hot, freshly prepared, nutritious meals (entre with vegetables and salad, dessert). No registration is required.

Doors open at 4:30 p.m. and coffee, tea, milk & water is served/Dinner is served from 5 to 6:30 p.m.

On EOTM days, if you're not able to come to the church during these hours, you can pick up frozen meals between 2 and 4 p.m. You need to register for this component of our EOTM meals.

Inn from the Cold - (IFTC)(winter program) - Hot, freshly prepared, nutritious meals (soup, entre with vegetables and salad, dessert) each evening of operation – middle of January to the end of February each year. This program is intended to provide assistance during the coldest time of the winter when heating & electricity expenses often eat away at funds otherwise used for groceries. No registration is required.

Doors open at 4 p.m./Hot soup and coffee is served @ 4:30/Dinner is served from 5 to 6:30 p.m.

During IFTC, if you're not able to come to the church during these hours, you can pick up frozen meals, daily, between 2 and 4 p.m. For this component of our winter meal program, you need to register on your first visit by showing ID for the number of meals you wish to pick up.
