The BSUC Strategic Planning Committee continues to move forward in its ongoing process for the re-imaging of BSUC into the future. A component and high priority of that process is a broad-based exploration of additional utilizations of the church building at 60 Bridge Street East.

This week, a questionnaire has gone out from the Committee to 40 organizations and agencies in the community, seeking indications of interest from them as to options of the development of community partnerships with BSUC in its existing space and with its community-based programs and services.
