SUNDAY WORSHIP COVID PROTOCOLS ...

IN PERSON ...

To make this opportunity as safe as is reasonably possible, certain pandemic protocols will guide our gathering:

- 1) Masks are to be worn for the entirety of one's indoor attendance.
- 2) **Social distancing** of 2 meters is to be observed.
- 3) Seating in the sanctuary will be pre-established to ensure social distancing.
- 4) On the first occasion of an individual's in-person attendance, provinciallyissued proof of vaccination will need to be presented for verification and record-keeping purposes.
- 5) Masked singing (congregational and choir) is welcomed.
- 6) An after-worship fellowship time is not possible at this time.
- 7) For those unvaccinated persons, worship will be available via Zoom technology.

Thank you for helping to ensure that in-person worship remains a possibility by minding the conditions under which it is possible.
